



MEET IN THE STREET Young Entrepreneurs Fair Application

Selected applicants will be notified by February 25, 2022

DETAILS: The Young Entrepreneurs Fair is an opportunity for youth ages 9 to 14 to discover their inner entrepreneur by creating and selling their handmade goods during Meet in the Street. The Fair will be held from 10:00 am - 2:00 pm during the festival. This event is held rain or shine. In case of lightning, festival will be canceled. There is no rain date.

RULES: All items for sale must be original and handcrafted. Types of products that can be sold include: handmade items such as jewelry, pottery, artwork and clothing. Handmade food and drink are also allowed. Please provide photo(s) of items to be sold or a detailed description.

DISPLAY SPACE: Booth space is 10'x10'. One table and two chairs will be provided. Electricity is not available, and generators are not permitted. Participant must provide tent and table cloth, if desired, and handle setup of booth. Setup is from 8:00 - 9:00 am on Saturday, May 7, 2022.

APPLICATIONS: Booth space for the Young Entrepreneurs Fair is limited. Participants will be selected by the Meet in the Street committee and notified by February 25, 2022. There may be no more than two participants per booth. All participants must be 9-14 years of age before May 7, 2022. All participants must sign a photo/video release waiver and be willing to share testimonial experiences after the event. Application must be filled out completely and accompanied by photo(s) of items to be sold. Photos can be emailed to ann@wakeforestchamber.org or submitted as hardcopies.

To help applicants prepare for success at the Fair, we are holding two free workshops prior to the event:

- Thursday, February 24, 6:00-7:30 pm — Creating Your Business Plan
- Thursday, March 24, 6:00-7:30 pm — Marketing Plans and Strategies

These workshops will be facilitated by business experts to help young entrepreneurs understand the basics of cost of goods sold, pricing, branding, and sales. Participation in the workshops will lead to greater sales success and increased profits at the Fair. Both workshops will be held at Wake Electric Membership Corp. in their lower-level community room, 100 S. Franklin Street, Wake Forest.
